#### MEALS

All meals served family style. **BE ON TIME.** Enter the dining room and be seated – otherwise you are in the way of those setting up and serving. Prayer and announcements will be made. We are expected to assist the camp staff in setting up, serving and cleaning of the dining room. Each table is to appoint two servers for each meal. Everyone is responsible for returning their own dishes and silverware to dirty dish containers near kitchen area

#### **CABINS/CURFEWS**

Please be considerate of your cabin roommates. Keep noise and disruption to a minimum. Young children (and those not so young) need their sleep. IN ROOMS BY 10:30PM; lights out by 11:00pm. Every person should be in their assigned cabin at 11:00PM. (Remember 7:30 AM is breakfast!!!)

#### **CLEANING**

Please leave cabins in a neat and orderly appearance. Remove all belongings before 1:00 PM Sunday. A check list in each cabin must be completed before we leave. Empty trash cans in outside bins. We would like to leave the camp in as good or better condition as when we arrived!
